BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

GRADUANDS TO DOCTORAL DEGREES

JAMES STEWART ANDERSON MCEWAN

Admitted to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy

This investigation of the effect of aspect ratio on judgements of slope in line segments of line graphs was based on the theory proposed by Cleveland and McGill (1987), in which it was argued that as aspect ratio was adjusted to produce line segments approximating a 45 degree slope, accuracy of judgement would increase. The findings of the thesis only partially supported this theory in that only as the mid angle of a pair of lines increased from 0 to 45 degrees did accuracy of judgement improve. However, accuracy declined sharply for angles greater than 45 degrees. The research revealed that Cleveland and McGills' findings were confounded by bias.

PAMELA CAWTE WINTER

Admitted to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (in Sociology)

Pahmi Winter came to the University of Waikato after a decade of travelling and working in many countries. She completed a bachelor degree majoring in philosophy and a masterate degree in sociology. She has taught and published and worked as a consultant in the areas of criminology and media studies. Pahmi, her husband and two young daughters live on Mt. Pirongia where they are planting a park. She has been lecturing in the Department of Sociology and Social Anthropology since 1989 while researching for her doctorate. Her doctoral research investigated the management of news production at Television New Zealand in the first years after it became a State Owned Enterprise. She argues that journalistic standards are compromised by being defined in terms of market performance and that discrepancies between journalists' and news executives' understandings are concealed by the incorporation of the journalists' understandings within the company's corporate culture. She is currently working on a book tentatively entitled *Whatever Happened to New Zealand Public Television*.

FIONA JEAN EDE

Admitted to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy

Having completed her B.Sc (Hons) at the University of Canterbury in 1984, Fiona spent nearly two years working at the Forest Research Institute at Rotorua. From there she went overseas and worked for a private chemical company in Finland. Upon returning to New Zealand, she commenced her D.Phil research in 1990, studying some aspects of the ecophysiology of *Paulownia* trees. This study included measuring such variables as photosynthetic rate of leaves under different environmental conditions, stomatal limitations upon photosynthesis, nutrient and biomass allocation over three growing seasons and the viability of root material for propagation of the plants. The research was supported by the *Paulownia* growers organization which aims to encourage land owners to grow these trees with a view to supplying the Japanese market, which has a well defined niche for *Paulownia* timber.

THOMAS FRANKLIN GEORGE HIGHAM

Admitted to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy

Tom Higham came to Waikato with a BA with First Class Honours and an MA awarded with Distinction from the University of Otago for work in field archaeology and some experience of investigating samples by physical science methods. His D.Phil work here continued these themes with the analytical science component becoming the major interest. His work aimed to optimise the C14 dating of New Zealand samples by liquid scintillation counting. Both sampling and counting procedures were improved. The work includes a careful evaluation and correlation of different dating materials in the New Zealand context, with a particular focus on shellfish species and moa eggshell. The result is dates (in optimum circumstances) with a standard error of only 25 years, comparable with the best international standards. The results have been extensively published and presented at international conferences. Tom is now one of that select group who can combine excellent Arts and Science experience in the support of Archaeology.

Dr Higham is currently a Research Officer in the University's Carbon Dating unit and is involved in a major project to match carbon dates to tree-ring dating of Southern Hemisphere wood in order to cross-calibrate with the very extensive Northern Hemisphere dendrochronological data.

KE MIN HUA

Admitted to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy

Before coming to New Zealand to extend his expertise, Hua Ke Min was a lecturer in chemistry at the South West Institute for National Minorities, in Chengdu, China. He had also worked for one year as a Fellow in Environmental Chemistry at the University of South Florida, USA. Ke Min first came to Hamilton as an interpreter when the Chinese Minister of Agriculture visited the Ruakura Research Centre, and following up contacts made in that visit he arranged to join the Growth Physiology Group at Ruakura to work for a D.Phil degree and learn modern techniques of protein purification, radioimmunoassay and molecular biology. His thesis work was centred on determining the effects of nutrition and growth hormone on the production of insulin-like growth factor 1 (IGF-1) in sheep, and the binding proteins which interact with this. He was able to demonstrate that growth hormone stimulates the production of IGF-1 and regulates the circulating level by affecting the amounts of binding proteins circulating. He was also able to show that the liver was the major source of circulating IGF-1 and that the stimulation of IGF-1 production by the liver depends on the sheep's nutritional status. Ke Min was supported by the Ministry of External Relations and Trade during his studies.

YOU GU WO

Admitted to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy

Wo obtained his MSc at East China Technical University of Water Resources and Hydrology in Nanjing in Physical Geography and Hydrology. Delayed by the Tianamin Square episode, he finally made it to Waikato University in October 1990. He commenced his D.Phil thesis on the long term trends of the water and bed levels of the Waikato River, particularly as they affect operation of the Huntly Power Station. The project was funded by ECNZ and run in close cooperation with the Waikato Regional Council. It involved detailed assessment of all the available historical gauging data for various cross sections of the Waikato River, as well as field work on the nature of the bottom sediments along the river bed. Using this data as well as records for river bedload sediment budget, he was able to refine a sediment budget for the river and develop a numerical model for the gradual reduction of the bed and water levels affecting the Huntly Power station, and project future trends. Since completing his degree, Wo has worked with a local Hamilton consultancy, Barnett and Associates.

WARREN TULLY

Admitted to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (in Chemistry)

After completing his Master of Science degree with First Class Honours, Warren Tully carried on to do his Doctoral research in organometallic chemistry. He investigated the preparation, structures and reactions of novel organic derivatives of manganese, which are not only of fundamental interest, but are also useful as reagents in organic synthesis. A new synthesis of an important class of compound, pyrylium salts, was established and new routes to other organic molecules were discovered. Since completing his Doctorate, Warren has been carrying out research into oxygen-scavenging materials with Trigon Packaging Systems (N.Z.) Ltd.

MICHAEL TAVENDALE

Admitted to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (in Chemistry)

Michael Tavendale gained his B.Sc (Hons) degree from the University of Canterbury, and was attracted to the University of Waikato for his Doctoral research by the graduate programme in environmental chemistry. His project was involved jointly with the Chemistry Department and the Forestry Research Institute at Rotorua. His work studied in detail the impact of chemicals from the pulp and paper mill effluent on the environment. This concentrated particularly on resin acids and chlorophenols in water, sediments and living organisms, and was based on experiments in both the laboratory and the field. Michael is planning to further his research work on the environment with post-doctoral appointment in the United States.

MARK BROWN

Admitted to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy

Mark Brown initiated his research career with an MSc project concerned with the investigation of the properties of transition metal oxyanions encapsulated in the sodalite cages of fespatooids. After graduating with First Class Honours Mark extended his research to include a variety of zeolite systems. The study of reactions constrained to nanometer dimensions is a new area of chemistry, referred to as nanochemistry. Mark has contributed to our understanding of the nanochemistry of transition metal oxyanions undergoing oxidation and reduction reactions in zeolite cages.

JOHN WILLIAM JANSSEN

Admitted to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (in Economics)

John Janssen completed his BMS in 1986. He returned to the University of Waikato in 1988 to study for a BSocSc (Hons), for which he was awarded First Class Honours in Economics. He subsequently joined the Economics Department as an assistant lecturer. His DPhil thesis involved the estimation of time series models of New Zealand's real exchange rate. A notable feature of New Zealand's recent experience of stabilisation and structural adjustment was the sharp appreciation of the real exchange rate during the mid to late 1980s. This appreciation generated considerable debate regarding the sequencing and timing of reforms, as well as the mix of macroeconomic policy. John's thesis sought to establish the role of various real exchange rate determinants, including the terms of trade. The econometric estimation utilised the recently developed techniques of multivariate cointegration analysis. Particular attention was paid to developing a methodology for overcoming small sample bias in the statistical tests. Since completing his degree, John has taken up a position as a policy analyst with the New Zealand Treasury.
